Letter of Support: Bell Street Safe Routes to School

The Sacramento County Disability Advisory Commission Physical Access (DAC PASC) Subcommittee supports the Sacramento Area Council Of Governments Next Generation Solutions and Clean Air grant application for the Bell Street Safe Routes to School project.

This project is seeking funds for the construction phase of bicycle and pedestrian improvements around three schools and two parks: Dyer Kelley, Encina High/Greer Elementary, Howe Community Park, and Santa Anita Park. The project improves 2.4 miles of Bell Street from Hurley Way to Edison Avenue.

The DAC PASC reviewed and recommended the project in the May 19, 2026 meeting and strongly supported this Next Generation Solutions and Clean Air application. The project will support ongoing efforts to provide transportation equity, enhance safety and security for all travel modes including safe routes to school along Bell Street, and reduce reliance on vehicle travel.
