Letter of Support: Stockton Boulevard Complete Streets

The Sacramento County Disability Advisory Commission Physical Access Subcommittee (DAC PASC) supports the Safe Streets for All (SS4A) Grant application for the Stockton Boulevard Complete Streets Phase II project.

The project will seek funds for the construction of bicycle and pedestrian improvements along Stockton Boulevard from Florin Road to Mack Road/Elsie Avenue. The project will include elements to support a Safer System Approach by incorporating Safer People and Safer Roads programming from the National Roadway Safety Strategy into the project.

The DAC PASC reviewed and recommended the project in the May 19, 2026 meeting and strongly supported this SS4A application. The Project should significantly reduce roadway fatalities and serious injuries along Stockton Boulevard by allowing for separation between vehicle and pedestrian traffic.
