HHSCC Bylaws Revisions

1) Name change to the <u>Health and Human Services</u> <u>Coordinating Council</u>

Summary of Responsibilities

- 1) Working cooperatively with related departments and advisory bodies.
- 2)Promoting integrated health and human services planning across various planning process impacting health and well-being of the community.

Bylaws Revisions

- 3) Reviewing and making recommendations on health and human services budget and policy issues.
- 4) Serving as a forum for community concerns.
- 5) Prioritizing community needs and informing the development of appropriate plans for addressing those needs.
- 6) Providing the board of Supervisors with information and education on health and human services issues.

Membership Structure

Increases community membership to 10. Each Supervisor shall select up to two members

- Members must be geographically representative of each District's population.
- Preference should be given to individuals active in neighborhood associations, community collaboratives, or similar groups that reflect the interests and demographics of the District they represent.

Membership Structure

- 1) Expands total membership to 23 members.
- One member from each Member Advisory Board
- 10 Community Members (2 members from each district)
- 7 Ex-officio members

Membership Structure

Member Advisory Board Representation

- Adult and Aging Commission
- Behavioral Health Commission
- Children's Coalition
- Commission of the Status of Women and Girls
- Disability Advisory Commission
- Public Health Advisory Board

Executive Committee - Article IX

The executive committee shall be made up of the Member Advisory Board HHSCC members.

- The executive committee shall meet monthly on the second Thursday of each month (12:15 PM -1:30 PM)
- Their role is to plan for the quarterly meetings

Quarterly HHSCC Meetings

- Quarterly meetings will be held in the month of January, April, July and October
- The executive committee will agree on the topic and guests for each of the meetings
- The first quarterly meeting will happen on Thursday, January 8, 6:00 PM -8:00 PM
- The January meeting will cover Legal Pathways to Behavioral Health Treatment
